**Format for Abstract submission for oral presentations and posters:**

To present either a poster or an oral presentation, you must submit an abstract of your work with a maximum of 500 words (excluding Authors, bibliography) as a pdf, Arial 11 points, 1.5 line spacing and in English.

The Abstract must include:

- i. Name of the author/authors
- ii. Designation and Affiliations
- iii. Title of the abstract
- iv. Area of Interest
- v. Abstract: Background, Aim/Objectives, Methodology, Results, Outcomes, Implications, Conclusions and a maximum of 4 keywords (separated by semicolons)

**The PDF sent should be entitled and saved as follows: First author's name (last name, initials), Oral/Poster; Theme\*. (Eg: Jones T\_Oral\_EMS).**

**Acceptance communication:**

The Scientific Academic Committee will communicate selections within 4 weeks post deadline. At this time, the participant will be informed of the steps to follow to send either their poster or their oral presentation and to confirm their registration details in the conference.
